WINEMAKERS NOTES

Our Tallavera Grove Vineyard is situated on the limestone soils in the foothills of the Mount View region of the Hunter Valley.

This wine showcases the Mount View micro climate, typified by a complex mix of red fruits and mulberry notes, balanced against subtle oak and fine tannins. Its medium bodied style will complement a wide range of cuisine, from duck to lamb and beef dishes. While very approachable from release, this wine will reward extended cellaring.

VINEYARD

Established in 1994, our Hunter Valley vineyard, Tallavera Grove, enjoys a warm coastal climate specializing in the traditional local varieties of Semillon, Verdelho, Chardonnay and Shiraz.

Depending on the area of the vineyard, our 70 acres (28 hectares) of vines grow on terra rossa clay loams on limestone, red duplex loams over marly shales or alluvial brown loams on the creek flats. Some of the new alternative varieties which have flourished here include Vermentino, Sagrantino and Negro Amaro.
